- High tillering with good head size

- Good end use quality—good protein, strong mixing
- Medium late maturity, medium maturity in northern areas of adaptation

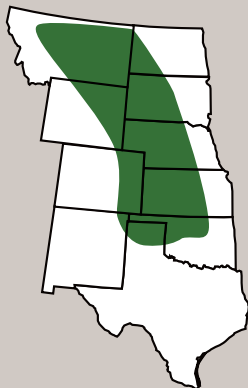

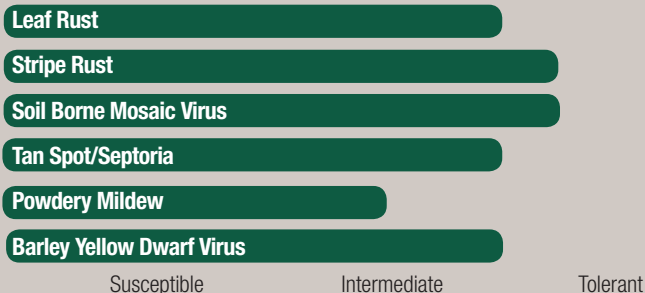
